'*C* 3 *Mar.* **Willie** / **Thomalin** (shps) [Th hunted love, was hit] 'opish shps, Wolf in shp'skin]

'*C* 4 *Apr.* **Thenot** / **Hobbinol** (shps), spurned by **Colin2**, reports his laye [Eliza] rt: **Romish Tityrus**, Bacchus]

'*C* 5 *May.* **Palinode** (cheerful, worldly) / **Piers** (puritanical) [two styles of clergy]

'*C* 6 *Jun.* **Hobbinol2/Colin3** [paradisal place, season / **Tityrus** dead; **C.** low in love] oet::seasons: winter=end]

SC 7 *Jul.* **Thomalin2** (shp, low) / Morrell (gts, high)
